"1/2" will give a wrong answer because the computer doing the marking (could be a computer anywhere in North America) does not recognize this as a correct answer, even through it is technically correct. If you do this right, your first quiz should go fine, assuming you have the correct answers. If you want to try again, use the second quiz as many times as you like until you are either satisfied or tired of it!
