| <p><u>Bug Survey:</u> goal is to assess the health of an aquatic environment by collecting identifying key indicator macro-invertebrates (i.e. collect bugs)</p> | <p><u>Setup of Ropes:</u> goal is to set up rope systems on the last portage to improve safety -</p> |
| <p><u>Knots and Ropes:</u> some basic practice with common useful knots</p> | |
| <p><u>Succession and Geology:</u> a walking tour to see first hand some of the key geological features in the park and to understand how succession has worked to provide ongoing plant habitat on the sides and top of the hills</p> | <p><u>Conifer Identification and Plant Life:</u> a walking tour with first hand identification of eleven different species of conifers found in this area and to see different stages in the prehistoric evolution of plant life, lichens.</p> |
| <p><u>Advance Chemistry:</u> detailed analysis of the water found in Nellie Lake and if time permits a comparison with the water found in Murray Lake</p> | |
| <p><u>Water Clarity, Water Sample Collection and Temperature Prob Activity (ALL)</u> performed from canoes lashed together for stability. All participants. Does not count as one of your activities.</p> | |
