

## KILLARNEY CAMPING EQUIPMENT LIST

### **CLOTHING:**

- be prepared for all weather
- avoid cotton (does not dry)
  - no jeans
  - fleece sheds water
  - no flip flops or sandals
- hiking boots or two pairs of shoes (wet/dry)
  - good rain gear
  - toque
  - mitts/gloves (two pair)
  - fleecy, wool layers (two) or winter coat
  - sun hat (peak cap)
  - socks x 4 or 5 warm and a special pair for sleeping
  - cloths to sleep in only
  - pants (two pair - not water absorbent - no jeans)
  - long sleeve shirt x 2 (light weight for warm day with bugs)
  - underwear
  - bathing suit
  - shorts & t-shirt x 2

### **GENERAL EQUIPMENT:**

- water bottle
- sleeping bag (wrapped in two garbage bags or equivalent)
- sleeping mat
- tent
- mug
- toilet paper for yourself
- toothbrush
- flashlight/headlamp
- sunglasses
- sun screen
- bug spray
- bug jacket
- (writing/reading material)
- (camera)
- (towel optional)
- DO NOT BRING electronics
- DO NOT BRING phones
- Day Back Pack
- Canoe Pack (can be rented for \$7.50 - first come first serve)

### **CANOE EQUIPMENT:**

- life jacket\*
  - whistle\*
  - paddles\*
  - duct tape
- \* will be provided by outfitters but you are welcome to bring your own
